Your father, Mateo KIKUCHI did however, register possessions and in accordance with the Federal Government's policy of liquidation of Japanese effects, the saleable goods were sold at public auction and the sales proceeds credited to him.

There is still a trunk lying in storage but it is possible that if this contained articles such as you described they may have been sold.

When time permits however, we will examine the trunk and let you know whether the photographs etc. are there.
