I tried all sorts of expedients to get myself around the country but all of them failed and I did not get in, either to Tashme or to the camps on the Revelstoke Sicamous area.

We have just received a Notice from the Sun Life Assurance Company in connection with an outstanding Loan of \$312.19 and Premium of \$22.71 due May 1st, 1947, under policy No. 2234167 in the name of your father, Kichinosuke Shimoyama.

We have been advised by the Sun Life Assurance Company that you are the named beneficiary under this contract and they state that this insurance will lapse soon after the beginning of May 1947 unless the above Loan is fully paid up. They also advise that this policy was taken out in 1937 and is a 24-year endowment policy for \$1000.00.
