Chattels bearing his name or that of his wife, Suano, File 9971, were found stored in a house owned by Motaro HAMAURA, File 6643, at Acme Cannery. These were inventoried on May 4/44 by Custodian agent, G.M. Harris with the goods of M.HAMAURA, List #486, on file 6643. These included a trunk which had not been declared. These chattels were sold at Steveston suctions for the net sum of \$39.32, and this sum was credited to the account of the above. The radio sold at Steveston suction No. 22 had been turned in to the Custodian by a Mr.McMartin. The above had not declared a radio.
