This woman signed a declaration to the Custodian on March 24, 1942. She was evacuated on May 30, 1942.

In her declaration she reported a Singer sewing machine, a trunk, kitchen utensils, a table, 11 chairs and a kitchen dresser left in the Japanese Hall, Prince Rupert. 12 chairs identified as belonging to this woman were sold at auction in Prince Rupert on August 3, 1944 and the net proceeds of \$11.25 were credited to her account. The remainder of the chattels are unaccounted for; See shipments below:

She reported a \$50.00 Victory Bond and three \$5.00 War Savings Certificates in her own possession. These did not come under the control of this office.
