PERSONAL PROPERTY SUMMARY

May 22, 1946.

Re: Sute (Mrs. Yosotaro) HAYASHI, #10507

This woman signed a declaration to the Custodian on March 24, 1942. She was evacuated on May 30, 1942.

In her declaration she reported personal effects in her own possession at Hastings Park. We assume she took these with her on her evacuation.

She reported \$12.00 worth of War Savings Certificates in her own possession and a bank account with the Canadian Bank of Commer, Prince Rupert with a balance of \$557.97. These items did not come under the control of this office.

The R. C.M.P. reported that this woman had surrendered a camera to the B.C. Police, Prince Rupert. This was released to the B.C. Security Commission on June 21, 1944 for shipment to Mrs. HAYASHI.

This file reveals no other liabilities of any kind.
