CHATELS:

In his declaration to the Custodian, the above declared the ownership of 1 saxophone, 1 bicycle, ten volumes of Encyclopedia, and sporting goods, stored at 1548 West 3rd Avenue. A visit to this address failed to disclose these articles. We communicated with Hikowo MASUDA regarding the whereabouts of his chattels, and he confirmed on January 26th, 1943, that he had disposed of these goods prior to his evacuation.

INSURANCE:

The declarant listed ownership of a \$1000.00 Life Insurance Policy No. 2302072 with the Sun Life Assurance Co., the policy being in his own possession. Subsequently "D" form on our file reveals that he owned two policies with this company, namely Nos. 2302072 and 2025212, both for \$1000.00. Our letter of November 30th, 1942, to the Sun Life Assurance Company advised them that as Hikowo MASUDA, until then an Internee, had been released, that we had no further interest in his insurance policies.

No property interests other than those mentioned above are found on this file.

In your registration with the Custodian you declared one saxophone, one bicycle, one ten-piece encyclopedia, a set of sporting goods left 1548 West 3rd Avenue, Vancouver.

Our representative visited this address with the purpose of offering protection to your chattels and was there informed that you had disposed of the above mentioned articles or taken them with you at the time of your evacuation. If this is correct, we assume that you have no chattels remaining in the restricted area of British Columbia requiring our protection.

Dear Sir:

Your file has now come under review and the following is noted.

At the time you made your declaration to the Custodian you stated that you owned a saxophone, 1 bicycle, one set of Encyclopedia, and sporting goods left at 1545 West 3rd Avenue. When our representative called at this address to remove these articles they could not be found. After correspondence with you as to the whereabouts of these chattels, you confirmed that you had disposed of them prior to your evacuation.

We note that you held two life insurance policies with the Sun Life Assurance Company of Canada, the policies being in your own possession. These did not come under the control of the Custodian.

It would appear that we have accounted for all the property of every kind left by you in the protected area which vested in the Custodian, and in order that you may confirm this, we are enclosing a stamped addressed envelope for convenience in replying.
