GENERAL SUMMARY

Re: Michirobe HAYASHI - Reg. No. 07102

Prior to his evacuation April 21/42, this man was employed by the Miland Logging Company, Simoon Sound, B. C. and lived in a bunkhouse there, board and lodging at \$25.00 per month, paid up to the time of his departure.

Chattels

In his declaration to the Custodian, HAYASHI reported ownership of one box of logging tools, valued at \$10.00, in custody of Nishimura boarding house at 409 Alexander St., Vancouver, B. C. An inventory, dated Sept. 30/42, shows one bundle cut cross saws in storage at 992 Powell St. in the name of H. HAYASHI moved from 409 Alexander St. As H. HAYASHI signed a statement (on file) Nov. 13, 1942, stating that "Goods removed from 409 Alexander St. to 992 Powell St. warehouse - 1 Bole Cut Cross Saws - I have no other chattels in the restricted area of British Columbia requiring protection", it is apparent that the box of tools reported by HAYASHI in his declaration and the bundle of saws referred to above are one and the same goods. An Auction sheet on our file dated Sept. 26/44, reveals sale of 2 Cross Cut Saws for the net sum of \$2.53. Cheque for this amount was forwarded to H. HAYASHI on May 4/45.

According to information in his declaration, HAYASHI has a house in Japan.

Bonds & Bank Account

In his declaration to the Custodian, H. HAYASHI reported owning:

- (1) One - \$50.00 Victory Bond, 1941, in the custody of the Royal Bank, Hastings and Main Sts.
- (2) About \$200.00 in Royal Bank, Hastings & Main Sts.

Neither of these possessions were brought under the control of the Custodian.

Liabilities

A claim was filed by the Dominion of Canada Income Tax Dept. in the amount of \$30.96 against H. HAYASHI for tax owing for the year 1940. This claim was referred to HAYASHI and on April 18/45 cheque was received from HAYASHI in settlement of same - Income Tax Dept. receipt dated May 21/45 on file. *Payment made through office.*
