PERSONAL PROPERTY SUMMARY

Re: Iwao (Roy) MATSUMOTO - Reg. No. 01846

This man was a gardener and lived at 1882 W. 4th Ave., Vancouver, in a house rented from Mrs. Tuson, 3500 Block on 5th Ave.

CHATELS

In his declaration to the Custodian April 4/42 MATSUMOTO declared ownership of an assortment of books and personal effects stored at 1882 W. 4th Ave. This man was interned April 21/42 and made a signed statement to Petawawa authorities that he owned books, magazines, garden tools and personal effects at the above address. On June 16/42, in reply to our letter of June 11/42, we were informed that MATSUMOTO stated that these effects were at the stated address - 1882 W. 4th Ave. - but believed that his mother had moved and taken them with her. On Oct. 20/42 the mother, Mrs. Tsuyako MATSUMOTO, declared some goods left at 1646 W 2nd Ave. This property is dealt with on file 10932. Mrs. MATSUMOTO stated that her chattels were being left at the rear of the apartment house at 2nd Ave. Nothing identified with the name of Mrs. T. MATSUMOTO or Iwao MATSUMOTO were removed from these premises according to our records. However, some goods were found in the small house in the rear of 1646 W. 2nd Ave. and were sold. The proceeds of this sale were credited to the account of Mrs. MORI, owner of the real property. None of the articles sold or inventoried at this address were similar to those declared by Iwao MATSUMOTO and it is possible that his mother disposed of his effects prior to her evacuation.

RADIO

MATSUMOTO did not declare ownership of a radio but in a statement of assets from Petawawa May 6/42, a radio was listed as being in the custody of the R.C.M.P. However, Mrs. INATA, file 11370, Dec. 16/42, requested release of a Victor Console Radio, receipt for which is made out to I. MATSUMOTO and dated March 9/42, on file 553. On May 19/45, in reply to our letter of May 2/45, MATSUMOTO states that he surrendered two radios, and that he believes the Victor Console belongs to Mrs. Inata. The proceeds realized from the auction of this radio Jan. 27/44 in the amount of \$16.00, less expenses of \$2.07, leaving a net amount of \$13.00 and credited to the account of I. MATSUMOTO, were transferred to the account of Mrs. INATA, file 11370.

In regard to the other radio mentioned in the letter from MATSUMOTO of May 19/45, a receipt filed back of a letter of June 7/47 on this file shows that Yoshimitsu YASUDA surrendered to the R.C.M.P. on March 14/42:

- 1 Philco Radio Serial No. 211903
- 1 DeForest Crosley Radio - no number - and speaker.
- 3 sets radios (homemade) and speaker.

The description given on the receipt agrees with the R.C.M.P. Exhibit Report No. 639 and shows the radio turned over to the Custodian on Dec. 17/43. This Exhibit Report is on file 11319, the file of Yoshimitsu YASUDA. However, the only radio equipment of any kind sold by this office for YASUDA was:

- A chassis
- Carton of Parts
- Homemade Set and Speaker,

sold Dec. 20/43. Mrs. Y. YASUDA, file 11317, stated in her letter of June 10/46, which is on file 11319, that the radios belonged to Roy MATSUMOTO. The sum of \$14.93 representing the net proceeds of the sale of the radio parts sold under the name of Y. YASUDA, was transferred to the account of Iwao MATSUMOTO on June 6/47.

CAR

MATSUMOTO declared ownership of:

1 1934 Ford Sedan Delivery

turned in to the R.C.M.P. The truck, described in the Specified Articles memorandum, was sold by this office Sept. 9/42, for the sum of \$185.00, less expenses amounting to \$27.21, leaving the net proceeds of \$157.79, which were placed to the credit of I. MATSUMOTO.

WAR SAVINGS STAMPS

War Savings Stamps in the amount of \$2.00 were declared by MATSUMOTO in his own possession. These stamps were received from the R.C.M.P. and placed in temporary safekeeping. This man was released from internment May 25/43 and accepted employment offered by the B. C. Security Commission in Ontario. On July 10/43 the Stamps were mailed to MATSUMOTO.

LIFE INSURANCE

MATSUMOTO declared the following policies with the Prudential Life Insurance Co., Vancouver Branch:

All these policies were in owner's possession and were not brought under the control of the Custodian.

At this time the account of MATSUMOTO shows a credit balance of \$172.72. A cheque for this amount was sent to MATSUMOTO June 7/47, addressed to Hamilton, Ontario, but the letter was returned by the Post Office. A cheque is going out today to the address of 44 Leonard Ave., Toronto, received from the R.C.M.P. Oct. 27/47.

This file reveals no other property of any kind.

Dear Sir:

We have received a letter signed "Roy Matsumoto", attached to our letter to you, dated May 2nd. We assume, therefore, that the letter we have received was signed by you.

In answer to your enquiry about your Ford Sedan Delivery Truck T-70, this vehicle was sold, as we advised you on January 14, 1943, and your account was credited with the net proceeds, which amounted to \$157.79.

In regard to the radios, the Victor Radio, which you state is the property of Mrs. Inato, has been sold, and the proceeds have been credited to your account. However, we have no record of another radio having been surrendered by you, and we would be pleased if you would send us a copy of the receipt given you by the police when the radio was turned over to them. This would give us something to work on in trying to trace your radio. As the matter stands now, the only radio mentioned on your file is the Victor, which you say belongs to Mrs. Inato.
