This woman signed a declaration to the Custodian on Marcy 28, 1942. She was evacuated on September 21, 1946.

In her declaration to the Custodian she reported a quuntity of household effects and foodstuffs. These were apparently numbered 1 to 23 and on May 22, 1942, were shipped to Mrs. MATAMAKA at Hastings Park. Also shipped were 4 trunks and 1 crate, not declared by Mrs. MATAMAKA but identified as her property. On September 15, 1942, she confirmed that she had received all property left by her in the protected area.

In her declaration she reported nine \$5.00 War Saving Certificates in her own possession. These did not come under the control of this office.

This file reveals no other property of any kind.

This summary is certified to be in accordance with information on file.
