MEMORANDUM To Files 562 & 3116

Re: Iyosuke HASHIMOTO, Reg. No. 03358, File 562

When interviewed by Mr. George Peters at Slocan, prior to his repatriation, Iyosuke HASHIMOTO reported a claim against Takejiro OUE, (Reg. No. 15053, File 3116) for the return of \$100.00 deposit. This deposit had, according to HASHIMOTO, been paid in connection with the self-supporting project at Alpine Lodge, Christina Lake, and was to be returned when leaving. HASHIMOTO stated he would turn in his receipt for this deposit.

The receipt has not been turned in by HASHIMOTO according to his file. In view of this and the fact that both HASHIMOTO and Takejiro OUE returned to Japan on the S. S. General Meigs, June 17, 1946, no action was taken by this office in regard to this claim.
