Dear Sir:

Your account with the Custodian shows a Credit Delance of 256.94. These funds represent the net proceeds from the sale of an outboard engine which was turned over to the Custodian by Naval Service.

On February 4th, 1 43 we forwarded to you our checue for 87.66. This money had been received from the Provincial Occurment as refund of one percent wage Deduction for 1 41.

In your declaration to the Custodian, you declared a Victory Bond in the name of your son, Akira and a Bank account in the Royal Bank of Canada, Main and Hastings Streets, Vancouver. These did not come under the control of the Custodian.

It would appear that we have accounted for all the property of every kind left by you in the protected area which vested in the Cuntedian and in order that you may confirm this, we enclose a stamped, addressed envelope for your convenience in replying.

This man, who was evacuated on March 23, 1942, signed a declaration to the Custodian on March 21, 1942.

In his declaration to the Custodian, he stated that he owned bedroom furniture, one table and 6 chairs, sewing machine (pedal), kitchen utensils and box of boiler tools. All at the Community Hall, Port Alice, B. C. There is nothing further on the file in regard to these articles. As the wife of Tomizo HASHIMOTO, Shizue HASHIMOTO File 2548, did not leave the protected area until September 8, 1942, it is more than likely that the family chattels were disposed of by her. See Letter 2 1/8/46.

This man declared a Victory Bond (in the name of his infant son Akira) in the Royal Bank of Canada, Vancouver. This did not come under the control of this office.

He also declared a bank account of \$500.00 in the Rayal Bank of Canada, Main & Hastings Sts., Vancouver. This did not come under the control of this office.

In addition to the items declared, this file shows that on February 4, 1943, we forwarded to Tomizo HASHIMOTO our cheque for \$7.66 to cover the sum credited to his account as refund of one per cent wage deductions for 1941, received from the Provincial Government.

The sum of \$56.94 was credited to this account as net proceeds from the sale of an Elto Outboard engine sold by the Custodian for \$62.00, less expenses of \$5.06. The engine had been turned over to the Custodian by Naval Service.

This file reveals no other assets of any kind. The file of Shizue HASHIMOTO, wife of Tomizo, reveals no assets of any kind.
