PERSONAL PROPERTY SUMMARY

CHATELS:

The above made his declaration to the Custodian on March 21st, 1942 and was evacuated on April 9th, 1942. He died on January 23rd, 1945. He declared logging tools left at 230 Jackson Avenue, but repeated efforts by our field staff failed to locate any logging tools. The writer personally made two unsuccessful efforts to find these tools at the address given. The place was wide open and no doubt the tools had been stolen.

SPECIFIED ARTICLES:

A camera was surrendered to the A.C.M.U and this was released to the B. C. Security Commission on May 4th, 1943, for shipment to Mr. HARA.

WAR SAVINGS CERTIFICATES:

The above declared \$15.00 in War Savings Certificates in his own possession. These did not come under the control of the Custodian. He also declared a \$100.00 Victory Bond partially paid in possession of E. & G. Logging Camp at Salmon Bay.

BANK ACCOUNT:

Mr. HARA declared a savings account in the Royal Bank of Canada, Main & Hastings St., Vancouver, in the sum of \$200.00. This did not come under the control of the Custodian.

No property interests other than those mentioned above are found on this file.

The above summary is certified to be in accordance with the information on file.


