This 50-year old logger, a Japanese National from Simoon Sound, B. C., signed a "JP" declaration form on March 23rd, 1942.

He was interned on the 24th June, 1942, and released August 25th, 1943.

This Japanese is a widower and has an adopted daughter living in Japan.

The following is a summary of the contents of this file as disclosed by a review made today.

Real Property: None.

Stocks: None.

Accounts Receivable: Refund of transportation costs (\$9.65) was obtained from the B. C. Security Commission (July 14/43) and remitted to Japanese on September 4th, 1943.

Bonds, Shares, etc.: A \$50.00 Victory Bond, declared to be in the Royal Bank of Canada, East End Branch, Vancouver, was sent in to this office for safe-keeping (Nov. 7/42) and later forwarded to Japanese (Sept. 9/43).

The Royal Bank advised this office (Oct. 5/42) that this Japanese had owned another \$50.00 Victory Bond, which he had sold (Mar. 26/42), and received proceeds (\$49.34).

Bank Accounts: A balance of \$515.08 was declared to be in an account with the Royal Bank of Canada, East End Branch, Vancouver. Residue of this account (\$297.72) received from Royal Bank on September 16th, 1942, and credited to this account.

Life Insurance: None.

Liabilities: A claim of \$18.15 registered (Mar. 17/42) against this Japanese by Gihai KAWAHARA (File 1746) was rejected (Nov. 17/43), Creditor being so advised and given address of debtor.

A second claim of \$83.86 registered against "T. Hamazumi" was referred, and rejected (May 29/43) by alleged Debtor.

Funds: Funds were remitted from time-to-time and there are no funds in this account at the present time.




