PERSONAL PROPERTY SOMMARY

Rei GMOTANI, Koli - Reg. No. 08052.

Koji CMOTANI signed a declaration to the Custodian on April 4, 1942 and was evacuated on April 5, 1942.

GRATTRIS: He declared a Fishing Rod and Tackle at 1755 West 3 rd Ave, in the custody of his mother. His mother, File 11254, declared on July 9th 1942 that she had moved to 1642 West 2nd. Avenue and listed some chattels which she was leaving at that address. No fishing rod and tackle was included and we can only presume that these were shipped to Koji by his mother.

SPECIFIED

ARTICINES: He declared a Marconi Portable Radio and a Univer Camera stored with the R. G. M. P. The radio was sold for the net sum of \$16.44 and the camera was shipped to him on May 23, 1945. The proceeds of the sale of the radio, less 0.08, being postage on Camera, which amounted to \$16.36 were remitted to the Japanese on May 25, 1945. The R. C.M.P. Receipt is on file.

MORETS

RECEIVABLE: A refund of 1% Wage Deduction for the first six months of 1941 was received from the Provincial Collector and remitted to Koji OMOTANI on May 20, 1943. This amounted to \$3.51.

BONDS: He declared \$45.00 worth of War Savings Certificates in his own possession. These were not brought under the control of the Custodian. This file reveals no property other than that mentioned above.
