



Re letter from Tomejiro HIKIDA dated June 16ths All the Japanese effects found at 546 Ewen Avenue, Queensboro, were removed and sold at New Westminster audtion, August 30th, 1944. The sales proceeds were credited to File 5406, Suejiro Tsuchida as there were no effects of other Japanese identified.

There were however, several bundles of old clothing removed to our storage at the Buddhist Temple which were subsequently destroyed as they were found to be full of vermin and moths. In addition some clothing was also discarded when the goods were originally removed for the same reasons. I recall very clearly the removal of these goods and Mrs. Scherneck was positive that everything belonging to the Japanese was taken away, except for the itmes she had purchased herself from the Gustodian.

To confirm the foregoing I visited this place again today and could find nothing in the attic referred to by HIKIDA.
