The above who made his declaration to the Custodian on March 28/42 and was evacuated on June 4/42, declared the following:  
1 motor boat, the "HARUMI" valued at \$850.00 in custody at Vancouver, B.C.  
1 Singer sewing machine, kitchenware, personal belongings, in care of Mr. S. MASUDA, Jameson Mills, Powell River.  
2 Beds, kitchenware, bureau and personal belongings valued at \$245.00 and fishing nets worth \$500.00 at the Terra Nova Cannery, Eburne, B.C. We received a completed net form from the above on Aug. 14/43.  
Custodian agent, C.C. Robinson inventoried nets tagged with the name of the above at the Terra Nova Cannery on Feb. 23/43 and these have been disposed of as per net statement on file dated Aug. 27/43, for the sum of \$200.00 and this sum was credited to the account of the above.  
Personal effects declared by the above at Powell River were shipped to his wife, File 590, at her request, on May 16/42.  
Personal effects of the above were inventoried by Custodian agent, G. M. Harris at the Terra Nova Cannery, House #17, on March 9/44 and removed to auction, as per List #588 on file. These have been sold as per Chattel Schedule on file for the net sum of \$17.78, and this sum credited to the account of HAMAOKI. *15 No 14M*  
HAMAOKI, through the B.C.S.C. asked for the money from sale of his nets and this was remitted to him on Feb. 27/45.

SPECIFIED ARTICLES:

According to information supplied to this office the above was the registered owner of a fishing vessel, the "HARUMI", which was sold through the Japanese Fishing Vessel Disposal Committee for the net sum of \$591.50, and this sum was paid to the above on June 22/42. Full details are given on Specified Articles Summary on file.

MONEYS

RECEIVABLE:

The above filed a claim against Jinkichi NAKAMURA, File 384, in the sum of \$135.00. In accordance with a request contained in a letter from the above dated Nov. 20/43, this claim was dropped and no further action was taken by the Custodian.  
In July, 1945, the account of the above was credited with the sum of \$1.98, being a refund from the B.C.E.R., security deposit for light.

BONDS:

The above declared a \$100.00 Victory bond in his own possession. This did not come under the control of the Custodian.

Your file has been reviewed and it is noted that when you made  
your declaration to the Custodian on March 28th, 1942, you declared one motor  
boat, in custody at Vancouver; a Singer sewing machine, kitchenware and personal  
belongings in care of Mr. S. MASUDA, Jameson Mills, Powell River; and some  
chattels and nets at the Terra Nova Cannery, Burne, B.C.

The effects left by you at Powell River were shipped to your wife  
at her request on May 16th, 1942. All household effects found by the Custodian  
at House #17, Terra Nova Cannery, in your name, were sold at auction for the net  
sum of \$15.80, and this sum was credited to your account with this office.

Your nets were sold for the total sum of \$200.00 and a Custodian  
cheque for this amount was remitted to you through the B. C. Security Commission  
at your request on February 27th, 1945.

Your fishing vessel, the "HAKUHI", was sold through the Japanese  
Fishing Vessel Disposal Committee for the net sum of \$591.50 and this sum was  
paid to you on June 22nd, 1942.

In July, 1945, your account was credited with the sum of \$1.98, being  
a refund from the B. C. Electric Railway Co., representing security deposit for  
light.

You filed a claim in the sum of \$135.00 against Mr. Jinkichi HAKAMURA.  
However in your letter of November 20th, 1943, you asked us to drop this claim  
so no further action was taken by this office.

You declared a \$100.00 Victory Bond in your own possession. This did  
not come under the control of the Custodian.
