

Sir:

On behalf of myself and my brother, p/w #408 - IMAGAWA, Yukio, I hereby wish you will kindly arrange to send me one cloth bag and one wicker-basket, and my brother's one cloth bag to us in this camp at your earliest convenience.

All of the above had been shipped from Duncan, B. C. on or about April 21, 1942 with us, and understood that they had been sent to the Hastings Park, Vancouver, B. C. from the boat, chartered by the government. They were tagged with our respective names.

I believe that the shipment charges of our above baggage should be paid by the government, since the government had ordered our evacuation and apprehended us.

Dear Sir: Re: Personal effects of internees.

We have a letter from the British Columbia Security Commission relative to personal effects of several internees. Copy of this communication is enclosed.

We have not examined the contents of the suitcases and boxes but it occurs to us if they contain worn clothing you might find use for the articles in camp and may wish to turn them over to the owners rather than to allow the goods to remain in storage.

It will be noted from the enclosed letter that the majority of the internees have credit balances with us; we have inserted the amount in red type; so that we could pay the charges if you wish us to send the goods. We do not know what facilities you have for storage and it may be that you would not permit them to wear their ordinary outside clothing.

If you would like us to make an examination and send you the list, this will be done upon receipt of your instructions.
