This woman signed a declaration to the Custodian on April 4, 1942. She was evacuated on August 31, 1942.

In her declaration she reported a quantity of household effects. These were apparently numbered 1 to 9. 7 pieces were shipped to her at Hastings Park on May 20, 1942. 2 pieces being a bed and spring were sold at auction in Port Alberni in January 1944, and the net proceeds of the sale in the amount of \$10.25 were credited to the account of Mrs. MIYAMOTO.

In her declaration she reported 19 \$5.00 War Saving Certificates and a \$50.00 Victory Bond in her own possession. These did not come under the control of this office.
