PERSONAL PROPERTY SUMMARY

This man was evacuated on March 26, 1942. His Declaration to the Custodian was signed the day of his evacuation.

In his Declaration he reported several boxes of household goods in the warehouse of the B.C.Pulp and Paper Co., Woodfibre, B.C. All the Chattles belonging to this man, left at Woodfibre, were shipped to Vancouver and stored at 992 Powell Street. These Chattels have all been accounted for as follows:

One Carton of household goods and a baby chair were shipped to Mrs. Horinaka on May 20, 1943.

A Mattress, baby tub, wash tub and baby buggy were released to Mrs. Horinaka while she was still in Vancouver on June 29th, 1942.

The five chairs were sold July 25,1944 for the net sum of \$1.74 which was credited to his account.

A bedframe and spring were found to be valueless and were discarded as shown by the memorandum of July 25,1944 on File No.1974.

One trunk and one double bed were stated to be at the Union Station, Vancouver, at the time of this Declaration. It is assumed that these were taken with him on his evacuation.

The box of tools, the sewing machine and a gramaphone were left in the care of Charlie Collieuth of Woodfibre, B.C. who acknowledged on August 8, 1942 that these were in his care. Nothing further appears on the file in regard to these articles, and it would appear that these are still at Woodfibre.

Horinaka declared twelve \$8.00 War Savings Certificates in his own possession and a Bank Account with a balance of \$4.00 in the Royal Bank of Canada, Main and Hastings, Vancouver. These did not come under the control of this office.

A refund of 1% wage deductions for 1941 was received from the Provincial Collector, Vancouver. This sum was remitted to Horinaka on January 25,1943 (77.73)


