FEDERAL PROPERTY SUMMARY

August 13, 1946.

Re: Toshio HOSHINO, Registration No. 09023

This man signed a declaration to the Custodian on March 25, 1942. He was interned on May 29, 1942 and released on December 22, 1942.

In his declaration he reported a 30-30 Savage rifle in custody of the B. C. Provincial Police. Firearms were handed by the R.C.M.P. and did not come under the control of this office.

He reported a \$4.00 War Savings Certificate in his own possession. At the time of his internment this was turned over to this office and after his release was sent to him on August 30, 1943.

He reported a \$2,000.00 life insurance policy with the London & Scottish Life Assce. Co., the policy in his mother's possession. This was collected from his mother at the time of his internment and sent to him on September 7, 1943 after his release. He surrendered the policy and on November 24, 1943 a cheque for \$313.90 was forwarded to HOSHINO through this office as the cash surrender value of the policy.

This file reveals no other property of any kind.

1. The above noted individual was interviewed voluntarily at the Montreal Post-Office, 440, St. J. St., at the 27th instance by the writer. In the questioning of this man, he stated that he refused to go to camp, as was indicated.

2. In view of the above and acting on instructions received, BENOIT was taken into custody by the writer, transported to the Quebec Immigration Building, located near the subway of the Military authorities and records were obtained which will be retained on file at this office.

3. The two Service Certificates in possession of this man and taken by the writer, will be filed attached to this report, together with Form 204 covering same.
