PERSONAL PROPERTY MEMORANDUM

Securities: In his Statement of Assets and Liabilities, dated May 29, 1942, Masanobu KAWAHIRA advised the Custodian that he was the owner of \$20.00 worth of War Savings Certificates, which he had surrendered at the Immigration Building, Vancouver, B.C. On May 20, 1942, the B.C.M.P., at Vancouver, B. C., forwarded to this office four (4) \$5.00 War Savings Certificates, which were being held for the account of this Japanese.

On February 9, 1944, KAWAHIRA requested the Custodian to obtain the cash surrender value of these Certificates and on August 27, 1945, we forwarded to him at the Camp our cheque, amounting to \$16.60, representing redemption value of his four (4) \$5.00 War Savings Certificates.


Bank Account KAWAHIRA also advised the Custodian, on May 29, 1942, that he had an account with the Bank of Commerce, Duncan, B. C., in which he had a credit balance of \$11.50. We communicated with this Branch on June 15, 1942, and on June 22, 1942, this Bank forwarded to us their cheque, amounting to \$11.54, representing the balance of this Internee's account. These funds were placed to the credit of KAWAHIRA with the Custodian.

On August 5, 1943, the B. C. Security Commission forwarded to this office their cheque, amounting to \$4.00, for the credit of the above Japanese. This remittance represented a refund of KAWAHIRA's transportation fare from Paldi to Vancouver on March 15, 1942.

All funds held at this office for the credit of the above Japanese were liquidated by remittances to him at the Internment Camp.

No property interests, other than those mentioned above, are found on this file.


Please note that the above has been repatriated to Japan. At the time of repatriation, the following transactions took place:



the control of the Custodian.

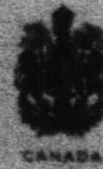


