

PERSONAL PROPERTY SUMMARY

In his declaration to the Custodian, dated March 20, 1942, Shigeru Mori stated that he had made an initial payment of \$5.00 on a \$50.00 Victory Bond, which he was purchasing through the Bank of Montreal, Port Alberni, B. C. This statement was confirmed by the Bank on June 25, 1942, at which time they advised that the Internee's equity in this Bond amounted to \$4.09. On July 15, 1942, the Bank of Montreal forwarded to this office their money order, amounting to \$4.09, which was deposited to the credit of the above noted Japanese with the Custodian. These funds were remitted to the Internee at the Angler Internment Camp on August 29, 1942.

On September 14, 1943, the B. C. Security Commission forwarded to this office their cheque, amounting to \$56.00, representing a refund to this Internee of his transportation fare from Sproat Lake to Vancouver, B. C. These funds were forwarded to the Internee at the Camp on November 24, 1943.

On October 26, 1945, the account of this Japanese was credited with an amount of \$2.38, representing a refund of B. C. Electric Railway Security Deposit for light. This amount was included in the Internee's repatriation funds.

Chattels During the course of an investigation to determine what goods belonging to Japanese are held in public warehouses in Vancouver, Bowman Storage Limited revealed that the following goods, belong to the above, are stored in their warehouse:

- 1 Bed Spring
- 1 Bundle Bed Ends
- 1 Mattress

Storage charges in the sum of \$44.00 are outstanding, which would appear to be considerably in excess of the value of this bed.

No property interests, other than those mentioned above, are found on this file.


