Re: Mr. Monteiro IGARASHI, Reg. No. 12057

In his declaration to the Custodian on March 21, 1942, this man reported he had been renting a 6-room house for \$20.00 yearly rent, the rent being paid up to date. On November 7, 1945, we received an offer from the owner of the land of \$25.00 for the house which Mr. AGARASHI apparently owned. On November 17, 1945, we accepted this offer by wire and letter but we have no record of receiving payment and no further correspondence in regard to this matter is on file. There was, however, a charge of \$1.61 for telegrams sent to the owner of the land. *payment*

Dec 12 1942
This man reported a chesterfield, linoleum and engine parts left in his former residence. In July, 1942, Mr. W. A. WHITE, who apparently was looking after these articles, sold the chesterfield for \$10.00, which amount was credited to Mr. IGARASHI's account. Mr. IGARASHI objected to the purchase price and requested that the chesterfield be returned from the buyer and shipped to him, together with the linoleum and a Japanese bath which had not previously been reported. Through the B.C. Security Commission Mr. WHITE was instructed to ship these to him and when we heard nothing further in this regard we assumed that this had been done. In October, 1944, we received a letter from Mr. IGARASHI stating that he had not received these articles and our records showed the \$10.00 still to Mr. AGARASHI's credit. In August, 1945, on Mr. IGARASHI's request, we remitted the \$10.00 to him. Although we have written several letters to Mr. WHITE we have no further records of the linoleum, engine parts or Japanese bath. *I had placed value of \$20.00 but would accept \$20*

In his declaration this man reported 38 packages held at the C.P.R. depot, the waybill for which was in his possession. On March 25, 1942, 13 packages were released to Mr. IGARASHI and on April 9, 1942, the balance of these packages were released to him.

This man reported one \$50.00 Victory Bond in his own possession. He also reported the amount of \$5,072.38 to his credit in the Royal Bank of Canada. These do not come under the control of this office.

This man reported the amount of \$345.83 to his credit with the Japan and Canada Savings Co. The list of depositors of this company as at December 31, 1942, does not show the name of this man and it is therefore assumed that he had withdrawn all his funds from his account.

The records of the Japanese Fishing Vessels Disposal Committee showed that this man owned a motor vessel "Bernice C", New Westminster licence 1816, which was sold on March 6, 1942 for the sum of \$1000.00. After the supervision expense of \$10.00 had been deducted, the amount of \$990.00 was paid on March 16, 1942, to Tsutomu KIMOTO, acting as agent for Mr. IGARASHI.

On April 11, 1945, our records show transportation expenses in connection with this vessel were credited to Mr. IGARASHI's account in the amount of \$21.75, which was received from the Dominion Government in full settlement of the claim for expenses incurred in connection with the impounding of the vessel "Bernice C", also known as "M. I."
