Eight \$5.00 War Savings Certificates were being held by the Custodian for this Internee and at his request were surrendered for their cash value of \$32.27 on September 24, 1942. These funds were subsequently liquidated by remittances to the Internee at the Camp.

On November 19, 1942, Messrs. P. S. Ross & Sons forwarded to this office, one \$5.00 War Savings Certificate, in the name of Yoshinori MURAKAMI, which was found in the office of the Cameron Lake Logging Company, and this Certificate is presently held in safe-keeping at this office.

A bequest of \$5.00 was made to the Internee on November 15, 1944, and these funds, together with a \$2.00 Transportation Refund from the B. C. Security Commission, total the Internee's present credit balance of \$7.00.

One cloth bag and one Kori, declared by this Internee, are held in Custodian Warehouse, 604 East Cordova Street, Vancouver, B.C.

Will you please be kind enough to cash my War Saving Certificates which are at your office, and send me the amount of money, at your earliest convenience. I had twelve (12) five (\$5) dollars War saving Certificates when I

was detained at the Immigration Bldg, Vancouver, B. C. and the Commanding officer had confiscated all of them.

As I previously explained to you, I have no cash at all on hand and could not buy anything for my daily use, such as tooth-brush, tooth-paste, soaps, tobaccos, handkerchieves, razor-blades etc.

Your favourable consideration in the matter will be very much appreciated.

Dear Sir:

We are in receipt of your letter of the 14th instant, regarding your cloth bag and Kori, and in connection with your request that we make arrangements to deliver these articles to you, we regret to inform you that we are not able to comply with your request as these effects cannot at present be located.

We have taken all reasonable measures for protection of personal goods, involving considerable expense in the employment of caretakers, watchmen and night patrol, but in spite of this, a certain amount of breaking in and vandalism has occurred in our storage, from time to time, resulting in some items being stolen.

Burglary and theft are, of course, circumstances which sometimes happen to the most careful property owners even when the owner is in residence and after taking every precaution against such possibilities.

The police have been made aware of this situation and if the missing article should be recovered, you will, of course, be advised.

Your request and a copy of this letter will remain on our file, indicating the facts regarding this matter, and be available for review at any future time.


