

This can declared two \$5.00 War Savings Certificates, which were turned in to this Office by the R.C.M.P., and later cashed for \$8.11 which funds were remitted to Makagama at the Interment Camp.

#### Bank Assount

Makagawa declared a Bank Account of \$600.00 at the Royal Bank, Main & Hastings Street Branch. We were advised by the Bank that this account was closed on November 25th, 1936.

#### Chestele

According to Chattel List No. 377, 1 cloth bag, owned by the above named was removed from the Victory Rooms, 391 Powell Street to storage at 156 West 5th Avenue. Mr. Wills of our Chattel Department advised that this building was thoroughly remeasked and this bag is missing, probably stolen.

The file shows that certain household chattels were shipped from Clayequet, B.C. in this man's name and were released to him by the G.P.R. Freight Department - as no mention is made of these articles on Statement of Assets and Misbilitles filled in by Makagawa at the Interment Comp, we presume that they were disposed of prior to his interment.
