This woman signed a declaration to the Custodian on March 30, 1942, in which she reported the following assets.

A 1929 Plymouth Sedan in the Custody of the Vancouver Police. This car was Custodian Number C-48, which was sold in August 1942 for \$50.00. Expenses amounted to \$26.98. The balance of \$23.02 was credited to her account.

She declared a \$200.00 Victory Bond and \$15.00 in War Saving Certificates in her own possession. These did not come under the control of this office.

She reported a bank account of \$200.00 with Bank of Montreal, Main and Hastings, Vancouver. This did not come under the control of this office.

On February 25, 1943, the Toronto General Trust Corporation reported that they had a Certificate for 500 shares of B.C. Nickle Mines Limited, in the name of Yoshino KAWAMOTO, 1105 Nelson St., Vancouver. On March 1, 1943, we informed the Toronto General Trust Corporation that these shares did not come under the control of this office.

The B.C. Purchasers Association records show that this woman held 10 shares in that organization. When distribution is made of the assets of this association, this account will be credited with whatever share Miss KAWAMOTO is entitled to.

In a letter, November 27, 1942, this woman inquired about chattels left at N. TESHIMA'S place. These were the chattels belonging to her family and these are administered in the file of her father, file 1608.


