Dear Sir:

In reviewing our records we find that we are holding for you in trust one War Savings Certificate having a face value of \$10.00. We would appreciate your letting us know what disposition you desire to be made of relative certificate. If you desire it to be forwarded to you, you have but to acquaint us with your wishes.

We also find that when registering your assets with the Custodian in April, 1942, you declared that Mr. Takimoto of the Fern-ridge Lumber Company was indebted to you to the extent of \$122.35. We would appreciate your advising us whether this claim remains unchanged or whether you subsequently received payment of the amount due. In the meantime, we have referred the matter of your claim to Mr. Takimoto's solicitors, but would like to hear from you also in this connection.

Our records indicate that as of the end of December, 1942, whilst you were at Camp Angler, you had a credit balance with them at that time of \$278.50. Merely in order that our records may be complete, we would appreciate your advising us whether or not you obtained refund at Camp Angler of the total amount due or whether you left on deposit with them any sum of money. In either case, please give us full particulars.
