

A claim in the sum of \$100.00 was filed against the above by Mrs. Eiyasu KAWINISHI, File 11111, in March, 1943. At the request of the above the sum of \$39.23 was transferred from his account to the account of Mrs. KAWINISHI in part payment of this loan. On Nov. 26/43 a further sum of \$3.00 was transferred from the account of KAWAKAMI to the account of Mrs. KAWINISHI, leaving a balance of \$57.77 owing on this loan. There are no more funds in the account of the above and Mrs. KAWINISHI was written to on Nov. 30/43 advising her that we had asked KAWAKAMI to remit the balance direct to her.

There was a claim on this file in the sum of \$3.00 by Dr. UCHIDA, but this claim was withdrawn.

The above summary is certified to be in accordance with the information on file.
