Mrs. Tone Ichikawa was the wife of an employee of the Takshaahi Logging Camp at Call Creek, B.C. She made her declaration to the Custodian on April 2nd, 1942 and was first evacuated on May 3rd, 1942.

This file reveals no liabilities of any kind.

Tone Ichikawa declared ownership of a three room wooden house erected on a float ande of logs and situated at the Takahashi Logging Camp, Call Greek, B.C. Her other possessions included 3 beds, 2 stoves, 6 chairs, 1 table, kitchen utenails, all stored at the K. Takahashi Logging Camp, Call Greek, B.C. Hr. John Feden, c/o Hessrs. Tait & Marchant, Bank of Toronto Bldg., Victoris, B.C. purchased the interests of K.Takahashi and Go. Ltd., so on July 16, 1942 we advised them of the properties firs. Fone Ichikawa had listed with us and asked them to investigate and let us know if the house was properly closed and memoral. We received us reply to that or our follow-up letter of September 17, 1942, so on October 14th so wrote direct to the Natchman, Takahashi Logging Camp, asking him if the three room house and contents as mentioned above were still there and intact. On Howember 12th, 1942 we asked him for a reply to letter of October 14th. On December 10th Mr. Hadley of Bones Bay wrote that he had towed the Ichikawa house and contents up the inlet to his own timber claim. It was without guard for about three weaks and the house was broken into and a box of tools belonging to Takaha (file 10023) and an Aladdin Lamp belonging to Takaha (file 10023) and an Aladdin Lamp belonging to Takaha (Intermee file 1061) were missing. He made many onquiries but could not locate these goods. He offered his assistance in keeping watch of the house which we accepted on December 16, 1942, and as far as we know he is still doing this.

On May 8th, 1943 we received a letter from the B. C. Security Counts in anologing the form on which Yone Ichikawa requested release of three souden boxes and one large can, all containing kitchen utensils, to be shipped to her at Greenwood, B.G. from the Saumili at Bones Bay, B.C. On May 11, 1943 we instructed Mr. Hadley to ship the goods and mark the freight charges collect for the account of the B. G. Security Counts ion as well as the bill of lading and bill for any other expenses incurred. We also asked him for a report on the labilities property. Mr. Hadley found four wooden boxes containing kitchen utensils marked 'IGHIKAMA', and shipped them with the one large can to Mrs. I. Ichikawa at Greenwood On May 21st, 1943. Freight charges were 80s. We maked B. C. Security Gommission to refund Hadley this amount. The last report from Mr. Hadley under date of May 21, 1943 stated that the place is never without a watchman.

This file reveals no other properties of any kind.
