Finally on June 27, 1947, we advised Mr. Saisho that in the absence of a reply to our letter of June 27/47 by July 18th, 1947 we would assume that the above amount was owing and would apply the small balance of \$3.40 in his account with this office as part payment of the above claim.

At this date no reply has been received from SAISHO and accordingly we are transferring by requisition the sum of \$3.40 from SAISHO's account to that of Sakubei IZUKAWA.

Claims on this file are accordingly closed.

Saisho declared he had an account with the East End Branch of the Royal Bank - we were advised by the Bank that they did not have an account in this man's name.




