Natsue (Mrs. Masao) IKEBATA, Reg. No. 04998

This woman signed a declaration to the Custodian on March 25, 1942. She was evacuated on May 17, 1942.

In her declaration she reported effects left at Sunnyside Cannery Skeena River. This file shows no disposition of these chattels and as there is nothing left at the Cannery we assume that she since received these effects. On June 11, 1945, we informed Mrs. IKEBATA of this assumption and received no reply.

The R.C.M.P. turned over to this office a radio and battery surrendered by this woman at Prince Rupert. This radio was sold and the net proceeds in the amount of \$14.77 were credited to her account. On receiving the radio receipt this amount was remitted to her on June 11, 1945.

This file reveals no other property of any kind.


