JP of April 11, 1942 - reported tailoring machine, 2 sewing machines and household equipment at 625 E. 15th, Vancouver. June 22, 1942, W.J. Jacklin, who had been investigating property for Custodian, reported that shop was closed, equipment sold and premises vacant. Landlord reported all charges paid. The shop had been operated by Mrs. Chisue Hoji, sister of Takeda, according to previous report from Jacklin.

Victory Bond - \$50.00 - March 5, 1943 Takeda stated he had cashed this April 25, 1942.

Savings Account - \$500.00 - March 3, 1943, the bank reported Takeda had withdrawn \$510.43 on April 27, 1942.

Sun Life Policy - Premium of \$34.80 was paid by Custodian from Takeda's funds. March 14, 1946, cash surrender value of this policy - \$217.39 was received and credited to this account.

Motor Vehicle - Ford Car, RCMP No. 33 - sold August 25, 1942, for \$127.00. Net proceeds of \$100.02 credited to Takeda's account. Car was appraised at \$150.00.

B. C. Electric Security Deposit - 2 totaling - \$8.11 credited to this account.

"I received the enclosed cheque amounting to  
 \$11.47 being balance of my credit with the Custodian, and  
 am returning the cheque unsigned for the following reason:

According to the statement from the Custodian  
 dated on January 12th. 1943, net proceeds of the sale of  
 my automobile, amounting to \$100.02 had been credited to my  
 account. So far as I know there were two payments made from  
 the above amount. One of them was \$28.75 for Dominion Income  
 Tax, another was a remittance to this Camp for \$25.00.

Therefore I understand that there is still \$46.27  
 in my credit instead of \$11.47 which is received today as  
 my balance.

I wish the Custodian to make a further check  
 of my account."
