Note: On March 24, 1942, Mr. Kishizo KIMURA, of J.F.V.D.C. reported that Hiroshi IKEDA was enquiring about his Neptune engine.

On July 7, 1943, Kenneth SOGAWA, File 2787, reported that Hiroshi IKEDA was the owner of a 4.5 HP Neptune engine.

The only Neptune engine reported by Naval Service or by the B. C. Police as having been seized in the Ocean Falls area is that, listed as Engine #119, sold by the Custodian and proceeds credited to account of Ichiro WAKIMOTO, File 765. This was so credited because Naval Service records showed that the engine had been taken from I. WAKIMOTO. The B.C. Police, Ocean Falls, reported this I. WAKIMOTO as owner of a 10-foot boat.

Neither WAKIMOTO or IKEDA declared ownership of boat or engine, and neither of these men have replied to our letters asking if they owned boats or engines.

Engine #119 is described as Neptune Outboard, Model C.B.64 A, Serial No. P6-1502, 6.6 HP, Year 1937. It was sold for \$40.00

The possibility exists that boat and engine were owned jointly by these young men.

Dear Sir:

In reply to your letter of the 10th instant.

The boat you have mentioned in your letter happens to belong to my son Hiroshi IKEDA, the address of whom I do not know. The only certain thing I know of his whereabouts is that he is somewhere in the Province of Ontario, so if you would kindly locate his address through the RCMP or the BCSC, and inquire to him directly about this matter, then I believe you will contact the rightful owner of this boat.

As to the information you asked describing the boat, I can only supply you with very scant facts since I have never seen the boat myself. I only know that it was a speedboat and was capable of travelling 35-40 mile per hour.
