On his declaration to the Custodian the above named declared he owned two \$50.00 Victory Bonds which he stated were in the possession of his mother, Mrs. Koma Yoshikuni. Mrs. Yoshikuni was contacted and advised that these bonds had been sold and proceeds used for medicine and personal expenses of the Internee. Kazuo Yoshikuni confirmed this.

Eight \$5.00 War Savings Certificates were held in safe-keeping at this Office and were redeemed for \$35.48 prior to Yoshikuni's departure for Japan.


\$137.60 was forwarded to this Office by the Royal Bank, Cumberland, B.C. and credited to the Internee's account with the Custodian.




