I have been trying for some time to locate the owner of the property on which the house belonging to Mishihama is built, and finally have discovered that the name is not Ooman as given in Nishihama's declaration, but is on the property which R.H. Ormond purchased from F. Koyama.

I interviewed Mr. Ormond today, and he states that he is aware that Nishihama makes claim to the ownership of the house, and to this he has no objection. There was no registered lease between Nishihama and Koyama, and Mrs. Ormond will not give a lease as he does not want the building on his property. He is quite willing to give a reasonable length of time to have the building removed, but if not removed in the near future he intends to tear it down as he considers it a fire menace,

Personally, I do not think the building is worth the cost of moving, and there is no land available to which it could be moved if there was any advantage in so doing.

It might be advisable for you to write Mr. Ormond direct regarding this matter, and you would then have his decision in a concrete form.


