PERSONAL PROPERTY SUMMARY

In his declaration to the Custodian, March 23, 1942, this man reported ownership of the following:

Chattels: One cross-cut saw, on peavey, one sledgehammer and one falling wedge, total value \$4.75, left at 409 Alexander. The file shows that we removed from 409 Alexander to 992 Powell Street, on September 30, 1942, one bundle of crosscut saws. On November 22, 1942, KANASHIGE reported, in addition to the tools already declared, one split wedge. On October 10, 1945, we sold at auction, an axe, sledgehammer and two crosscut saws for a total sum of \$5.50. The net proceeds of the sale amounted to \$3.90, which was credited to the account of Seiichi KANASHIGE.

While the articles sold and the articles declared do not agree, the value of the tools does not warrant any extensive investigation. It would seem that the items sold and credited to this account were in the bundle of tools, marked "Kanashige", which were moved from 409 Alexander to 992 Powell.

Bank Accounts: Japan and Canada Trust Savings Co. account in the amount of \$242.65. This man's name does not appear on the list of savings accounts as at December 31, 1942, which appears on the Japan and Canada Trust Savings Co. file #13806.

Royal Bank of Canada, Main & Hastings, Vancouver, B. C. \$104.60. Bank accounts did not come under the control of the Custodian.

This file reveals no personal property other than that referred to on this sheet.

This file reveals no real property interest.

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
