PERSONAL PROPERTY SUMMARY

June 14, 1946.

Re: Masao KAMEDA, Registration No. 11128

This man signed a declaration to the Custodian on March 24, 1942. He was evacuated on July 27, 1942.

In his declaration he reported personal effects at Hastings Park. We assume he took these with him on his evacuation.

He reported \$5.00 War Savings Certificate in his own possession and a bank account in the Royal Bank of Canada with a balance of \$30.00. These items did not come under the control of this office.

He reported a \$2,000.00 endowment policy with the Manufacturers Life Insurance Co. This did not come under the control of this office.

The R.C.M.P. handed to this office Baby Brownie camera surrendered by this man. This camera and two others belonging to members of his family were released to the B. C. Security Commission on November 17, 1944 for shipment to KAMEDA, as the receipt had been received and sufficient money to cover cost of mailing had been received from this brother, File No. 704.

This file reveals no other property of any kind.

In reply to your letter of October 23rd, we wish to advise that the three cameras, about which you asked, are still in our hands.

We are unable to ship cameras C.O.D., and as we have no funds to the credit of either yourself or your brother, Masao, we would ask you to kindly send us \$1.00 in stamps or Money Order. This sum should be ample to cover the cost of mailing these two cameras. The balance left after the postage is paid will be returned to you.

While there are funds to the credit of Ritsuko Kameda, we do not know whether your sister wishes her camera sent to Toronto or to Winto City. We are sending a copy of this letter to her. When we hear from her we will comply with her wishes in this matter.
