On April 10, 1943, Shigekazu KAMACHI wrote, in reply to our letter of April 2, 1943, stating "Yes, I have sold my farm implements in April 1942. I have brought my truck in July 1942." He continues: "I have no more property in the Protected Area for which the Custodian need care".

Bank Account:

KAMACHI did not declare a bank account, nor is one revealed on this file.

Specified Articles:

KAMACHI declared a fishing vessel, Reg. No. 2395, naval #090F in custody of Naval Authorities. This boat was damaged while in custody. Shigekazu KAMACHI agreed to accept \$600.00 as compensation for the total loss of his vessel. See Brown Edged Vessels Summary.

KAMACHI also declared a 1936 International $\frac{1}{2}$ - 1 Ton truck, motor #H.D. 2889 Serial No. 540L, value \$450.00. This truck was released to Shigekazu KAMACHI on July 7, 1942. See Chattels, above, KAMACHI stated in his letter of April 10, 1943, "I have brought my truck in July 1942." (- to Kamloops). See Brown edged Specified Articles Summary.


