PERSONAL PROPERTY SUMMARY

June 13, 1946.

Re: Tsutomu SHIMIZU, Registration No. 09982

This man signed a declaration to the Custodian on March 30, 1942. He was evacuated on May 1, 1942.

In his declaration he reported C.C.M. bicycle in his own possession. On July 26, 1942, he reported that he had sold this bicycle.

He reported box of school books and box of gardeners tools left in Victoria. These boxes were stored with the effects of this man's mother at the Willows and are handled on her file No. 2021.

He reported three \$5.00 War Savings Certificates in his mother's possession and a savings account in the Canadian Bank of Commerce with a balance of \$10.14. These did not come under the control of this office.

This file reveals no other property of any kind.
