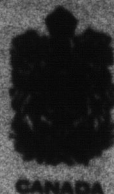

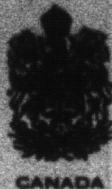
We are in receipt of your letter of the 22nd instant giving us an inventory of the effects of the above deceased.


