This man signed a declaration to the Custodian on March 20, 1942. He was evacuated on March 21, 1942.

In his declaration he reported goods left at the Sprout Lake Lbr. Mill. These were shipped as requested on releases dated May 16, 1942 and May 30, 1942.

In his declaration he reported that Kumao NAGANO owed him \$50.00. On October 20, 1942 he stated that this amount had been reduced to \$45.00. Debtor stated this amount was owing to Mrs. IWANAME, alias Mrs. KAWAKAMI. Creditor so advised and no further action taken by this office. *6-14-46 9879*


Please note that the above has been repatriated to Japan. At the time of repatriation, the following transactions took place:
