This man signed a declaration to the Custodian on March 20, 1942. He was evacuated from the protected area on March 21, 1942. Prior to his removal to Vancouver in March, 1942, this man had been employed by the McNair Shingle Company, Stillwater, B.C.

In his declaration, ISHIKAWA declared neither real property nor chattels and no property of this nature is revealed in his file.

ISHIKAWA did declare that the sum of \$96.00 was due him from the McNair Shingle Co. for 40 cords of Shingle Bolts at \$2.40 a cord, which he had cut. Settlement of monies due from the Robert McNair Shingle Co. was made to P.S. Ross & Sons liquidators of the assets of M. Ebisuzaki Co. contractors in connection with the cutting and chuting of shingle bolts at Stillwater. Statement of funds due ISHIKAWA, made up with the aid of the records of M. Ebisuzaki Co. and the assistance of Bunso TAIRA operator of one of the shingle bolt camps at Stillwater appears on File 1410. This statement shows the following funds due ISHIKAWA:
