Two claims were filed against the above:

Dr. H. Uchida. . . . . \$2.50

B. C. Electric Railway Co. Ltd., . . . . . \$1.34.

Dr. Uchida withdrew his claim.

We repeatedly wrote to ISHII regarding the claim from the B. C. E. R. but he failed to reply. We have today advised them that we have no funds from which to pay their claim but that we are forwarding ISHII the cash surrender value of his life insurance policy and enclose his address, so that they may contact him, if they so wish.

In his declaration of March 13, 1942, Kenji ISHII declared that he owed J. W. Kelly Piano Co. Ltd., the sum of \$80.00 on a piano. When he declared, the second time, in August 1942, he did not mention this claim. However, a claim for the sum of \$57.75 appears on the wife's file, 12142. We presume, in the absence of any recent claim by Kelly & Co. that the balance owing has been paid and we are in correspondence with the J. W. Piano Co. Ltd. in this connection. J. W. Kelly Co. Ltd. advise that the claim was settled in full in June 1942, by Mrs. ISHII. (23/12/46)

The above signed a declaration to the Custodian on March 13, 1942 and was evacuated on March 15, 1942. He evidently returned to Vancouver where he signed a second declaration on August 24, 1942.

CHATELS: In his first declaration, he stated he owned all the furniture at 763 East Georgia Street. Later, in August 1942, he declared no chattels and it is presumed that he sold or otherwise disposed of his property during the time which elapsed between his two declarations.

LIFE

INSURANCE: He declared two life insurance policies for \$1,000 and \$2,000 with the Monarch Life Insurance Co. Both policies were in his own possession. ISHII surrendered both policies and the cash surrender value cheques were forwarded to him through this office on October 2, 1945 and December 9, 1946.

This file reveals no assets other than those mentioned above.
