

I'm writing for Kiyoshi FUJITA, Jap Reg.#09284 who is claiming a radio. He received a letter sometime ago and was unable to answer it because he's in MacLeod, Alberta. Seeing that his radio was turned in by Yoshisuke MURATA in Kiyoshi's brother's name, Asao FUJITA, so he can't claim it unless he get the letter releasing it to him. Asao is in the internment camp now and is expecting to come out in the Spring so Kiyoshi decided to wait until he does. Asao will probably apply for it. Kiyoshi sent \$6.50 money order to you and he needs this money for another purpose so will you please return it. Thank you very kindly for the trouble.
