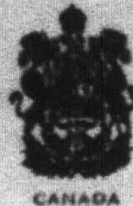



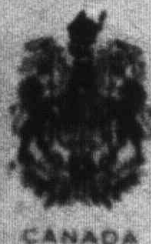

The above named did not leave a radio in the care of the Custodian nor did he declare having owned one on his J.P. Form or Statement of Assets and Liabilities.

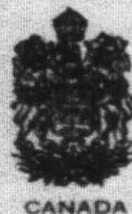
