ASSETS: No assets were declared by the above Japanese person and no assets of any kind whatsoever belonging to Mr. Fukuzawa are revealed on this file.


LIABILITIES:

No liabilities were declared by the above Japanese person when signing his J card on May 26, 1942, or when signing his undated Statement of Assets and Liabilities.

However, on August 15, 1942 a claim for \$10.00 was filed against this Japanese person by M. Nishiguchi Co., which debt was acknowledged by Fukuzawa. As no funds accrued to this man's credit with the Custodian, other than the sum of \$2.92 received from the Internment Camp and later released to the Treasury Department after this man's repatriation on October 2, 1946, this debt remains unpaid.

No other claims against this Japanese person are revealed on this file.






