PERSONAL PROPERTY MEMORANDUM

File No. 763

Takao HARADA

P/W A-24

In his statement to the Custodian, Takao HARADA advised that he held fifteen (15) \$10.00 War Savings Certificates at the Angler Internment Camp, and also had an account for back wages, amounting to approximately \$35.00, which was owing to him by the B. C. Security Commission. On August 4, 1942, the B. C. Security Commission forwarded to this office their cheque for the sum of \$27.27, being wages due this Internee.

On July 10, 1942, the Bank of Montreal informed the Custodian that Takao HARADA had a credit balance with their Bank amounting to \$13.08, and forwarded a cheque for this amount to the office for the credit of this Internee.

On August 13, 1942, the Custodian received a cheque from the Department of Mines and Resources for \$5.29, representing wages due the Internee at Red Pass, B. C., for the month of May, 1942.

At the request of Takao HARADA, the fifteen (15) \$10.00 War Savings Certificates were forwarded to the Registrar, War Savings Certificates, for their cash surrender value, and on November 18, 1942, the Custodian received cheques from this Department, amounting to \$121.54, for the account of this Japanese, which funds were deposited to his account with this office.

The B. C. Security Commission, in their letter of July 21, 1943, forwarded to this office their cheque, amounting to \$2.00, being a refund of the Internee's transportation fare from Woodfibre to Vancouver, B. C.

Several remittances have been made to HARADA at the Angler Internment Camp, which have reduced his credit balance with the Custodian to the sum of \$13.89. This credit balance is the only asset of Takao HARADA of which the Custodian has knowledge.

No property interests, other than the above mentioned are found on this file.


