

We wish to acknowledge your communication of the 4th instant, in which the above named has requested information regarding his account here.

This man's only asset consisted of sixteen War Saving Certificates. These were cashed and proceeds, amounting to \$129.54, credited to his account on November 6th, 1942. Since that time, remittances totalling \$69.80 have been forwarded to him for his credit in Canteen Fund and payment of 1941 Income Tax in amount of \$59.74, was made, on March 3rd, 1943.

These payments total \$129.54, and there is therefore no credit balance in internee's account here.

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
Please note that the above has been repatriated to Japan. At the time of repatriation, the following transactions took place:
