

Bank Account: On May 28, 1942, the R.C.M.P. forwarded to this office a Bank Deposit Book, covering an account in the name of the above, with the Bank of Montreal, Main and Hastings Streets Branch, Vancouver, B. C., and the balance of this account, namely \$269.65, was forwarded to this office on August 16, 1942. This balance has been reduced by numerous remittances to the Internee at the Camp, and at the present time HIKIDA has a credit balance of \$99.65 with the Custodian.

Specified Articles: On August 17, 1944, the R.C.M.P. delivered to the Custodian one Kodak Camera, held in the name of the above. On May 15, 1946, HIKIDA requested that the Custodian arrange to deliver this camera to him at the port of his embarkation for Japan, but the camera could not be located. It would appear that this article was stolen from the Custodian warehouse.

No property interests, other than those mentioned above, are found on this file.

On this date, subject surrendered himself voluntarily at the Hastings Park Manning Pool, and upon being questioned, it was ascertained that he was to have reported May 28th for evacuation from the Defence Area, which he refused to do. He was, therefore, arrested and escorted to the Canadian Immigration Building where he was handed over to the Military Guard.

Dear Sir:

We are in receipt of your letter of the 15th instant, regarding one Kodak Camera, Serial No. 79827, and in connection with your request that we make arrangements to deliver this camera to you, we regret to inform you that we are not able to comply with your request as the article required cannot at present be located.

We have taken all reasonable measures for protection of personal goods, involving considerable expense in the employment of caretakers, watchmen and night patrol, but in spite of this, a certain amount of breaking in and vandalism has occurred in our storage from time to time, resulting in some items being stolen. It would appear that your camera might have been taken under such circumstances.

Burglary and theft are, of course, circumstances which sometimes happen to the most careful property owners even when the owner is in residence and after taking every precaution against such possibilities.

The police have been made aware of this situation and if the missing article should be recovered, you will, of course, be advised.

Your request and a copy of this letter will remain on our files indicating the facts regarding this matter and be available for review at any future time.
