

TAKAHASHI, and also the sum of Seven Dollars and Seventy-Five Cents(\$7.75) under Section 34 of the Workmen's Compensation Act for Medical Aid, making a total due of Seventeen Dollars and Forty-Seven Cents(\$17.47).

We acknowledge receipt of your communication of the 2nd inst. with reference to our claim for \$17.47 against the above-named party.

Reference to our file indicates that the business referred to was registered with the Board on March 15th, 1926, under the name and signature of M. Takahashi, and it has been carried along continuously under that name ever since. We did find however that one report submitted to us on July 14th, 1936, showed the name of the employer as M. Takahashi but was signed "Hideo Takahashi". It is possible that the last-named party took over the operation and carried on under the name of M. Takahashi.
